

FAFSA Help Night for Seniors & Parents

February 15, 2010 – FAFSA Priority Filing Date

Franklin High School will hold a Free Application for Federal Student Aid help night on February 10, 2010 from 6:00 – 8:00 pm in Computer Lab 207.

Come get some help from a financial aid expert. A financial aid administrator from Wright State University will be available to answer any specific FAFSA questions.

The following needs to be done before February 10:

1. Get a pin (personal identification number) number by going to:
www.pin.ed.gov.
The student and the parent(s) both need pin numbers.
If you don't have computer access, your child can do this step at school.
Mrs. Peters in the Media Center will be glad to help the student.
2. Print out and complete (as thoroughly as possible) a FAFSA worksheet.
Go to: www.fafsa.gov and select FAFSA on the Web Worksheet (under column 1).
3. Bring your pin number, FAFSA on the Web Worksheet, 2009 tax return (or 2008 tax return if you are estimating your FAFSA to meet the Feb. 15 priority filing date) to the FAFSA Help Night.

Only have a question or two, but otherwise feel comfortable completing the FAFSA at home? Bring your questions and stop by the help session. We want to provide as much or as little help that families may need in order to complete the FAFSA and assist their senior to secure financial assistance for college.
